

# AROO: Zell am See-Kaprun turned into a Spartan hotspot again

The largest obstacle race series in the world, the Spartan Race, took place for the second time as winter edition in Zell am See-Kaprun on 11 and 12 January 2020. The only winter Spartan Race in the entire German-speaking area attracted 4,000 competitors from 33 nations, who brought the Spartan lifestyle back to the region.

Zell am See-Kaprun, 13 January 2020: In addition to participants from various European countries, athletes from the United Arab Emirates, Kuwait, Japan and Russia also travelled the long distance to start in the Winter Spartan Race in Zell am See-Kaprun. The enthusiasm sparked off by the winter race is also reflected in the record number of participants: the second edition saw an increase of over 1,000 registrations this year.

## **Kaprun as Spartan hotspot**

The Winter Spartan Race was fought in four disciplines: Spartan Sprint, Spartan Super, Hurricane Heat and Hurricane Heat HH12HR. In Spartan Sprint, the runners had to overcome 21 obstacles on five kilometres around Kaprun. In Spartan Super, the Spartans faced the challenge of up to 27 obstacles across more than ten kilometres. The Hurricane Heat disciplines were particularly demanding, starting at 4:00am on Saturday, leading over an unknown distance and lasting at least four or twelve hours. Solution-oriented, physically and psychologically demanding tasks were mastered by teams as well as individuals. Nearly one hundred young Spartans between the ages of four and 15 participated in the Spartan Kids.

Finally, at the official party "Kaprun meets Sparta", the presentation ceremony was held in Kaprun Castle and celebrated with Spartans and fans in an exuberant atmosphere.

Birthday home win Petra Eitzinger was able to fulfil her biggest birthday wish at the Spartan Super. She stayed clear of mistakes in the javelin throw and finished as winner at 1:35:19. Behind Eitzinger, Zuzana Kocumova from the Czech Republic, who gave birth to her daughter only three months ago, secured second place (1:38:24). Third was Nicki Johnson from the USA (1:41:53). The first place in the men's race went to Manuel Moriconi from Italy, who finished the more than 10 km course and 27 obstacles in 1:11:43. Second place went to last year's winner from Germany Lucas Kempe (1:12:11), third was Jérémie Gachet from France (1:12:24).

In the shorter sprint discipline on Sunday, Manuel Moriconi was again able to prove his strength and won by accomplishing the sprint in just 00:38:35. Frenchman Jérémie Gachet took silver (00:38:44) ahead of Peter Ceniga (00:39:39). The first place in the women's race went to Zuzana Kocumova (00:52:10), ahead of the Germans Katharina Blank (00:54:28) and Lena Weller (00:57:39).

We are already looking forward to the coming year, when an Aroo, Aroo, Aroo rings out again on 16 and 17 January!"

Registration for the Winter Spartan Zell am See-Kaprun 2021 on 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> of January opened on Monday, 13 January 2020, and the fastest Spartans will benefit from an attractive Early Bird rate.
